Follow the manufacturer's instructions for charging, storing, and handling your e-bike battery.



E-Bike and 🕌 E-Scooter Safety



Only use the original equipment manufacturer's charger to charge your e-bike battery.



Never charge an e-bike battery unattended or overnight. Never leave it plugged in when it is not charging.



Charge your e-bike battery plugged directly into a wall outlet. Never use charging strips or extension cords.



Avoid charging or storing your e-battery in extreme temperatures.



Do not modify or attempt to repair your e-bike battery.



Handle your e-bike battery with care – do not drop or submerge in water.
