
ELECTRICAL INSPECTIONS NOTICE

Potential Electrical Hazards Created with Water Meter and Metallic Water Supply Connection Replacement

Metallic Water Service Supply Connections are being replaced with new plastic lines in many towns and cities across Saskatchewan.

In many cases the existing water service is being used as the grounding means for the electrical service in the house. Removal, or modification of the metallic water line may disrupt the integrity of the electrical grounding system for the house. There is also a **high possibility** that due to a fault on the power line, and the method of grounding used at the time, a hazard may exist to anyone working on or around the water line replacements.

Always Assume there is electricity on the water piping system, and work on them as if they are energized. Extreme caution should be exercised when cutting or modifying Metallic Water Supply Lines.

Please contact a licensed Saskatchewan Electrical Contractor immediately and have them check, and/or repair, the grounding connection to the electrical service.
