

# Carbon Monoxide Summer Safety

Carbon monoxide (CO) exposure isn't just a winter risk; summer poses dangers too, especially with single-pipe portable air conditioners. These units exhaust indoor air outside, causing replacement air to enter through cracks, gaps, or chimneys.



If enough air is drawn out, the pressure change can disrupt vented appliances like water heaters, leading to CO spillage through draft hoods and allowing harmful gas to enter your home.
